What is Encore?

Encore is a program for individuals with a wide range of cognitive and physical challenges with an emphasis on memory care. Encore memory care is for individuals with moderate to late stage memory loss.

Encore Program

The Encore programming approach is slower-paced in a safe, engaging, and personalized environment to serve an individual's specific needs. With patient encouragement we tailor programs to enhance participants' abilities and to retain their independence to perform tasks.

Our caring staff can provide partial or total assistance to a participant who is not independent with:

- Activities of daily living
- Ambulation
- Sudden changes due to memory or physical abilities

Encore Activities

Encore activities are designed to maximize individual creativity, provide self expression, build memory recognition and memory retention. These activities assist participants to converse, socialize and stay in the present with meaningful interactions within a small group setting.

Daily enrichment includes time to socialize, discuss current events, de-stress, and be involved in physical activities.
